Associated Pallet Inc. has a rich history of progressive growth and experience in the industrial wood market. Founded by Carl "Mickey" Perry in October 1964 with \$100 and five employees at Five Spot (near Cleaton, KY), the pallet mill has since expanded into the logging, sawmill, grade lumber, and kiln lumber industries.

A stable supplier of pallets and other industrial wood products, Associated Pallet increased its annual production with the addition of automatic nailers in 1974 and a Turbo Max nailing machine in 1994.

Sawmill operations began in 1968 to insure a ready supply of raw materials, leading to the eventual development of a state-of-the-art band mill that produces grade lumber, chips, dust and bark.

Our experience in kiln-drying pallets began in 1987. A new kiln was constructed on-site in 2000 to provide our customers with economically priced treated pallets.

Since 1979, our fleet of trucks has enabled us to make "Just In Time" deliveries to our customers.

We have received recognition from several customers for outstanding service. We are the first business in Kentucky to be ALSC certified to treat pallets, and are the only wood products company to be certified by Caterpillar tractor.
